

**Title:** Internship vacancy notice

**Location:** Bosnia and Herzegovina

**Duration:** 2-6 months

Vasa prava BiH (VPBiH-Your Rights BiH) offers a limited number of places for interns of legal or economic/managerial background, which are filled subject to current organizational needs of the VPBiH field offices throughout the country. The internship should last between two and six months. An internship does not constitute a commitment to future employment with VPBiH. VPBiH is not in a position to provide financial assistance to the selected interns.

The intern's work will vary based upon her or his interests, but will include a good bit of writing, researching, and possible legislative work. Related tasks will include advocacy work and general office coordination, identifying and undertaking legal/project research on specific topics relating to current fundraising and project plans of VPBiH and monitoring general legal developments on subjects relevant to VPBiH. The intern should be organized and detail oriented, have excellent writing skills, and able to work well on her or his own.

Knowledge of Bosnian/Serbian/Croatian language is considered a plus, but is not required.

Background information:

Vasa prava BiH have been involved in provision of free legal aid to refugees, returnees and IDPs from 1996. At first as a part of UNHCR's Legal Aid Network, and from 2004 as a fully national NGO Vasa prava BiH, direct successor of the network. So far, Vasa prava BiH has assisted over 400,000 returnees, displaced persons, refugees, minority groups and domicile vulnerable individuals. In 2007 alone, Vasa prava BiH assisted over 34,000 beneficiaries in all legal issues relating to the return process, including property repossession, social, economic and cultural rights, and discrimination in access to employment, utilities, education and social welfare, as well as other human rights guaranteed under the European Convention on Human Rights and other international legal instruments.
